Word Museum Did you know the meaning of a word may change over time? Many English words we know now had different meanings a long time ago. One example is the word *nice*. Around the year 1300, *nice* was first used in English to mean 'stupid.' Two hundred years later, *nice* began to carry a "better" meaning. If people said a book was written *nicely*, they meant the book was written 'clearly' or 'carefully,' not 'stupidly.' After 1800, *nice* began to take its modern meanings like 'kind'

or 'friendly.' Since then, people have thought of *nice* as a word with "good" meanings. A "good" change of a word's meaning like this example of *nice* is called

AMELIORATION. Though we don't use *nice* to mean 'stupid' anymore, it is fun to know how much a word's meaning can change from its start!
