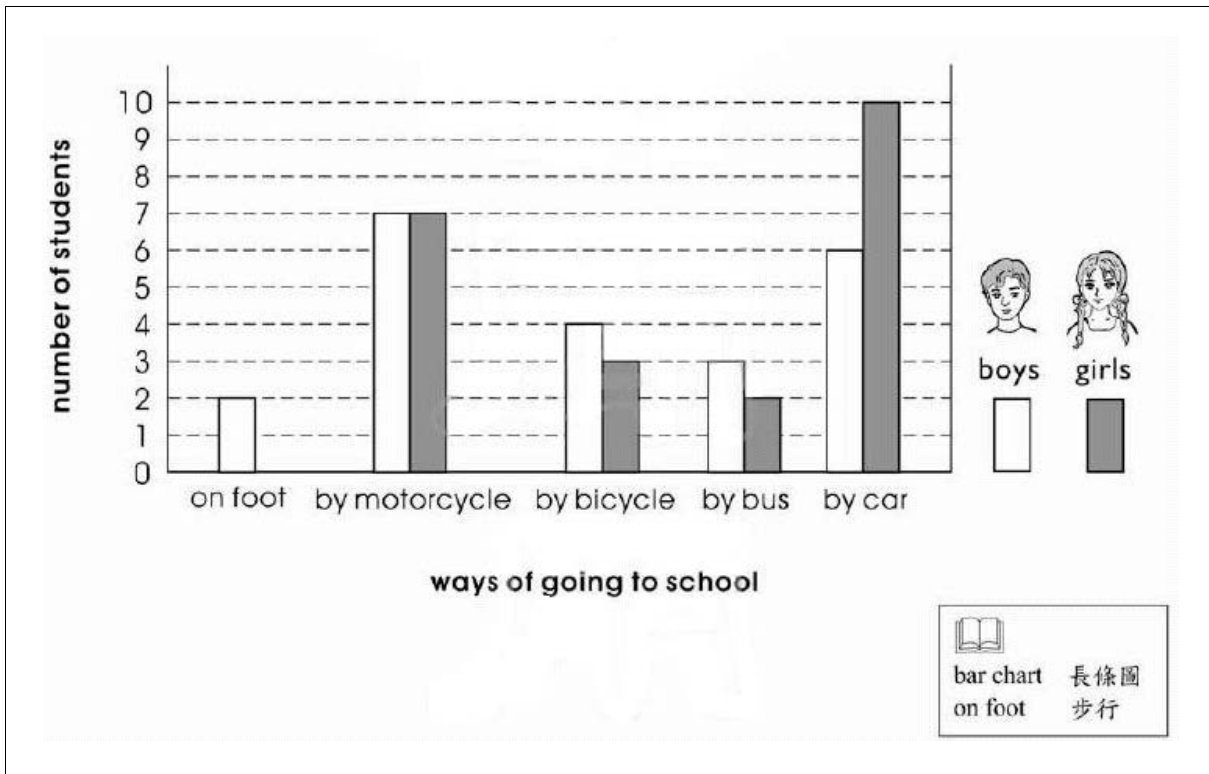

of them do lose weight, they soon gain it back or gain even more.

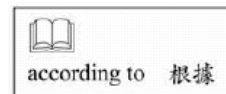
